Avalanches, debris flows, floods, landslides & rock falls

The INTERPRAEVENT Congress in Bergen 2020 calls for contributions from a wide spectrum of stakeholders in the field of natural disaster risk reduction. We welcome contributions from scientists, practitioners and students, policy makers at all levels of administration and other stakeholders, such as civil protection or insurance companies. Contributions about any constituent part of the integrated natural risk management and governance cycle are welcome.

Focus will be on integrated management of natural hazards and risks, equally considering causes of disasters as well as measures of prevention, preparedness, response and recovery in the view of global change.





Topics

The Congress will cover a variety of integrated and multidisciplinary research and practical expertise in the field of natural hazard risks. Included are snow avalanches and slush flows, landslides involving debris, sensitive clays, rock falls to rock avalanches, and floods including pluvial floods.

Theoretical studies, new theories and technologies, practical field case studies including best-practice cases and cases with lessons learned, are welcome in order to prevent damages from, and improve the resilience to, future natural disasters. The challenges of climate change and the need for climate change adaptation, environmental and gender issues, urbanisation and spatial planning dilemmas, as well the latest international commitments such as the Sustainable Development Goals 2030 and the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030, are topics to be handled in parallel with our joint natural hazards and risks reduction efforts.

Extended Abstracts

The corresponding author must be indicated in a clear manner. Extended Abstracts are limited to 2 pages (one page counts between 2 500 and 3 000 characters, spaces included), and should include at least one figure or table. Only abstracts in English will be considered.

Papers

The corresponding author must be indicated in a clear manner. Papers are limited to 6 - 8 pages (one page counts between 2 500 and 3 000 characters, spaces included), and should include a short abstract, tables and figures. Only papers in English will be considered.

Please note all Papers have to be submitted through the Editorial Manager.






Submission Guidelines

Oral Presentation

The oral presentations will be selected from all accepted Extended Abstracts or Papers.

Posters

The authors of all accepted Extended Abstracts or Papers can present their subject as a poster during the congress, if their contribution is not selected for an oral presentation.





Student Award

PhD and master's students (under 30 years of age and registered at an academic institution) are invited to submit a Paper and participate to be selected for a student award.

Registered student papers will be rated by the scientific and technical board before the congress. Five contributions will be selected and the students will be invited (complimentary conference participation; including welcome reception and accommodation, as well as contribution to travel costs) to give a presentation at the conference.

The best presentation will be selected by the conference participants and awarded with 3000 Euros.
